## “Reaching for the Presence”

Dear Friends in Christ,

I was thinking recently about the Spirit Bound play, and thought of another possible theme verse: Matthew 16: 31. It's the story where Jesus is walking on water and Peter gets out of the boat to do the same but then starts to sink. **“Jesus immediately reached out his hand and caught him, saying, ‘You of little faith, why do you doubt?’”** The Spirit Bound verse is, *“I want to know Christ and the power of his resurrection...”* (Philippians 3:10).

God's greatest desire is to reach out to touch and catch each and every person; to love, to save, and to be in a grace-filled relationship with us. Through the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ, God has definitively reached out to do just that. And by the work of the Holy Spirit, in Word, Sacraments, Worship, Prayer, and the innumerable daily ministries of the members of the Body of Christ, God continues to reach out to all people.

Yet for many people reaching out to God is a struggle. We come up against barriers within us and around us that can prevent us from reaching for the presence of God; or, if we are reaching out desperately, it can seem God is not there to reach out to catch us. This year's Spirit Bound drama is one story of a diverse group of people who discover how God has been reaching out to them, and then how God wants them to help others reach for the presence of God. I hope you will come and experience their music and drama at least once this summer (*and bring someone with you whom you think might relate*).

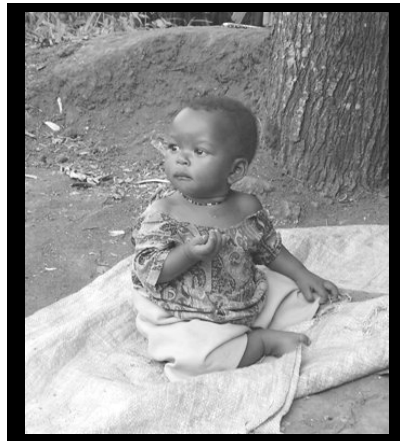
## Midwife Cradle Overflows with Donations



Saturday May 10<sup>th</sup> was a special day for Mothers of Tanzania. Social Ministries organized a large-scale baby shower for the mothers of Tanzania by holding their annual Midwife Kits for Tanzania Project. Enthusiasm for the project reached new venues and gained support from people who are hearing about it for the first time such as friends, neighbors, and coworkers.

Gods blessings poured in as word of the project spread, and thanks to the generosity of your donations we are delivering more kits than ever to Africa. Christus Victor and Lily of the Valley shared the joy and exhilaration of new life with our sisters in Tanzania through the 353 Midwife Kits that were assembled and packaged for shipping on Saturday May 10th.

Through supplying these Midwife Kits, you have helped in the fight to reduce the high mortality rate of newborns and mothers caused by unsanitary birth conditions.
